

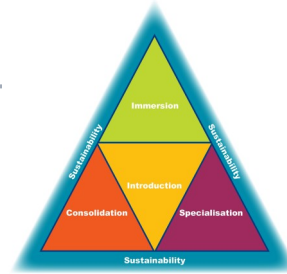
#### What is it?

This programme runs over 3 terms giving teachers hands-on, practical support in teaching their language and is structured in clusters to make networking with other teachers easy.

#### Who is it for?

##### Teachers:

- With experience in teaching a language
- Who have completed a professional development programme such as the ILEP Introduction Programme or TPDL
- Who would like ongoing support and new ideas for their language teaching
- Who want to share and exchange ideas and resources with other teachers, through (digital) networks
- Who want/need hands-on practical ideas and resources that work for teaching and learning



#### Offered in this programme:

- **Tailored cluster groups** based on teachers' backgrounds and needs
- Regular and ongoing **support** over three school terms
- Hands on **practical help and resources**
- **Classroom visits** for individual support
- A guided **teaching-as-inquiry project** suitable for appraisal
- Three face to face **workshops**, one every term
- Opportunity for structured **language learning** (subsidised)
