This programme runs over 3 terms giving teachers hands-on, practical support in teaching a new language and is structured in clusters to make networking with other teachers easy.

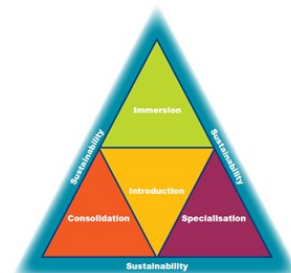
Who is it for?
