Categories

- Category I - Secondary School Junior (Year 7-10): minimum 200 characters
- Category II - Secondary School Senior (Year 11-13): minimum 300 characters
- Category III - Tertiary Institution Category minimum 500 characters

Eligibility

- NZ citizens or NZ permanent residents
- Mandarin or any Chinese dialect is not the home language spoken by either parent

Judging Criteria

- Content (idea, originality and creativity)
- Language (vocabulary and grammar)
- Structure (organization and style)
