

English Language assistantship programme in Valencia, Spain

Applications now open!



The English language assistantship programme in the Spanish autonomous community of Valencia is a new initiative of the Spanish Ministry of Education. Eligible candidates are English native speakers holding a university degree or university students in their last year of studies, interested in the Spanish language and culture, or teachers seeking to upskill in Spanish.

The candidates selected will spend a semester, from January to June 2018, assisting Spanish teachers with the teaching and practice of oral English. All available positions are at primary schools in the Valencian Community.

The main goal of the programme is to provide foreign students with the opportunity to teach English at Spanish primary schools (16 contact hours a week). The programme also allows Spanish students the opportunity to get to know a different culture by interacting with English native speakers.

Language assistants in Valencia will receive a monthly stipend of €1,000 to cover accommodation and food expenses, a medical insurance and an induction course on arrival. All travel costs will be borne by the selected candidates.
