

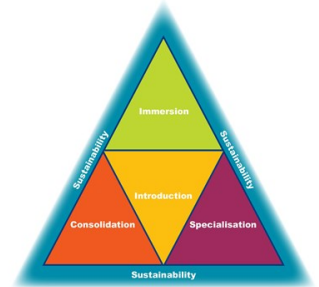
Foreign Language Assistant Programme



A programme to improve teacher capability and lift student achievement

Programme Outline

The Foreign Language Assistants Programme is a programme which allows New Zealand schools and language teachers to have a native speaking Foreign Language Assistant in their language classes for one school year. The scheme is available to schools offering French, German or Spanish at primary, intermediate and secondary level.



Foreign Language Assistants can support schools, language teachers and students by:

- working with teachers and individual students and groups to improve and increase the use of the target language
- helping to increase confidence
- team-teaching
- supporting teachers with multilevel teaching and differentiation
- creating, sourcing and adapting materials and resources for the target language
- preparing mini-lessons about culture or situational language
- modelling writing or pronunciation

Employing a Foreign Language Assistant

Sharing a Foreign Language Assistant can be arranged by you and your school with other schools in your learning clusters or Community of Learning. Alternatively, ILEP can arrange this with other schools in your area.
