


10 Mindframes for Visible Learning:

This is John Hattie's latest work. He has written about mindframes before (see Visible Learning for Teachers) and this book brings together his previous meta-analyses and focuses on the critical area that makes the most difference to student success: the mindframes of the educators.

Each chapter begins with a questionnaire for self-reflection and includes recommendations for action, sample problems, checklists, exercises, evidence-based knowledge and suggestions for further reading. In that sense it really is a workbook for teachers to examine their attitudes, develop their skills and advance their own educational expertise.
