

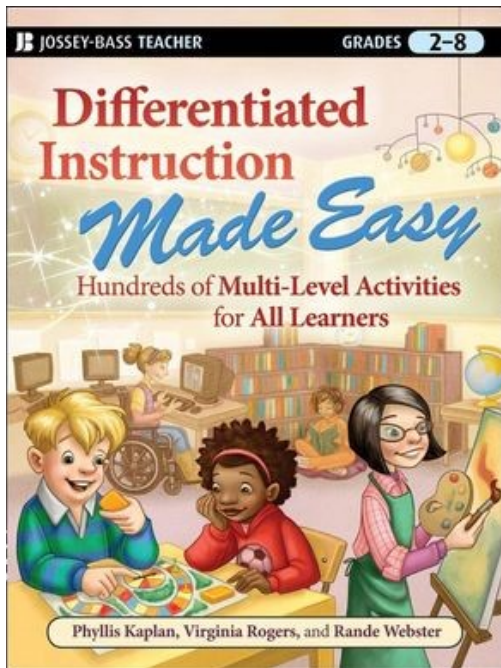
# Book Review

## Differentiated Instruction Made Easy:

Hundreds of multi-level activities for all learners

This book is aimed at students in Grades 2-8 in the American system. Although it does not include Languages specific activities it does have many ideas that could be adapted for the Language classroom and covers such areas as Reading, Spelling, Writing, Media, Art and Music, Fantasy, Peace-making and Service Learning.

The authors focus on giving students choice with individual contracts that specify the number of tasks to be completed by a particular time. The various choices suggested are in checklists, task cards or task wheels. From a language development point of view I can see that the task wheels would work particularly well by layering wheels with different types of information and putting it together to make longer sentences.

At the back of the book are templates for multilevel gameboards, task cards and wheels etc.
