- Many great prizes to be won during the Fun Fun Korean Quiz time for audiences.

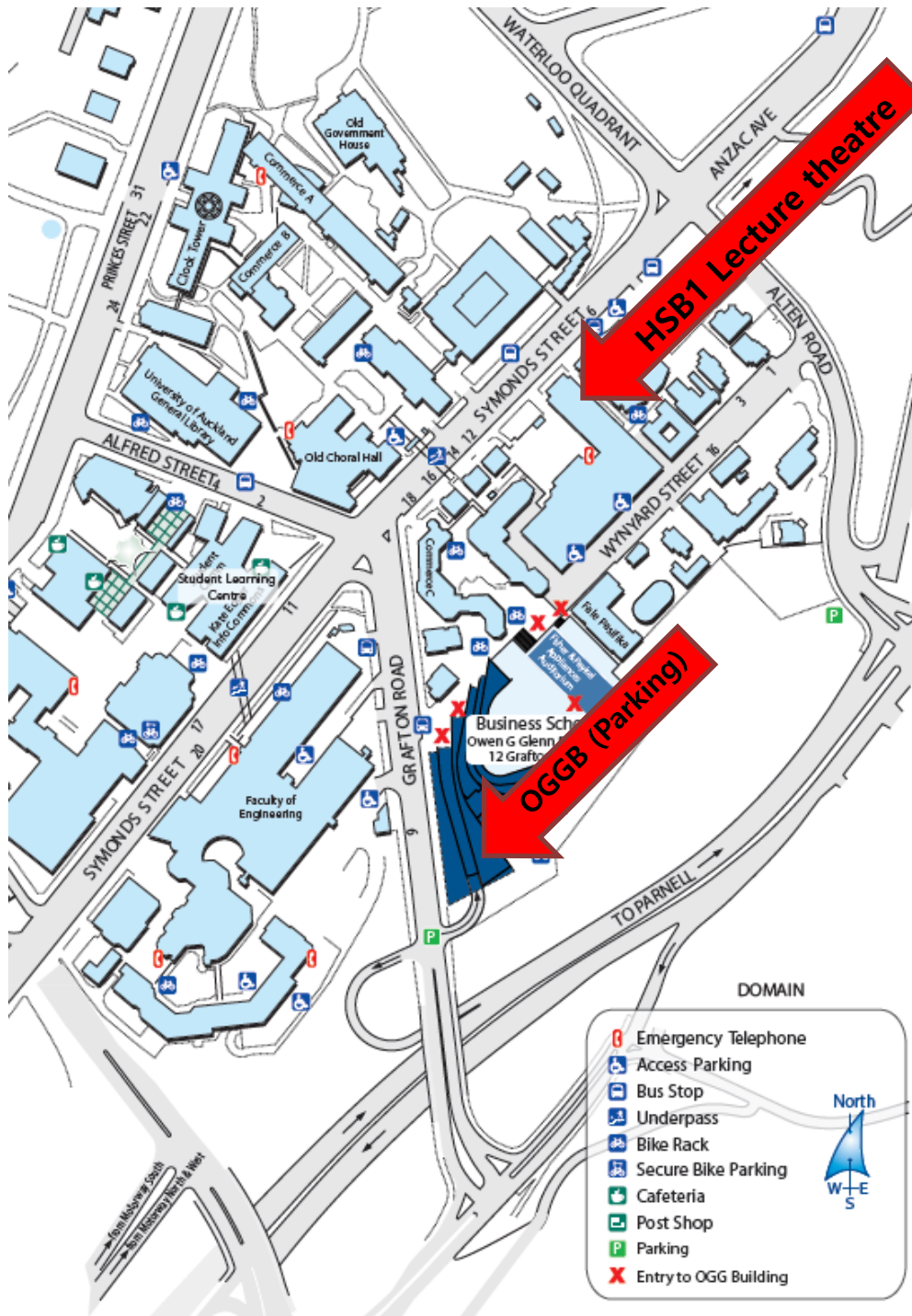
