

Ideas for Language Use in a Primary/Intermediate Classroom

<p>Classroom set-up</p>	<p>Posters with classroom instructions, frequently used words and phrases, classroom items labelled in TL, school map in TL, world map in TL</p> <p>Students names in TL, books labelled in TL, student badges - laminated and safety-pinned - in TL</p> <p>Toilet pass that has the expression on it asking for permission to go to the toilet - similar pass for going for a drink of water. Have laminated and available so students can grab it and bring it to you when they need to use it.</p> <p>Sign on the door with the expression “sorry I am late” for anyone coming in after start of lesson.</p>
