

## Ideas for Language Use in a Primary/Intermediate Classroom

<p><b>Classroom set-up</b></p>	<p>Posters with classroom instructions, frequently used words and phrases, classroom items labelled in TL, school map in TL, world map in TL</p> <p>Students names in TL, books labelled in TL, student badges - laminated and safety-pinned - in TL</p> <p>Toilet pass that has the expression on it asking for permission to go to the toilet - similar pass for going for a drink of water. Have laminated and available so students can grab it and bring it to you when they need to use it.</p> <p>Sign on the door with the expression “sorry I am late” for anyone coming in after start of lesson.</p>
<p><b>Beginning of day routines</b></p>	<p>Greetings - standing, bowing etc. if Asian languages</p> <p>Date and time</p> <p>Taking the roll</p> <p>Weather</p> <p>Ideas for cheat sheets - classroom instructions, asking permission to do things e.g. go to the toilet, phrases that students might say daily</p>
<p><b>Start of lesson preparation</b></p>	<p>Equipment needed e.g. pencil case items</p> <p>Activity locations</p> <p>Classroom instructions</p> <p>Asking to borrow items</p>
<p><b>Lesson endings</b></p>	<p>Formulaic phrases for end of day, giving homework</p>
